BUILDING THE BOND: PLANNING AND RECOMMENDATION



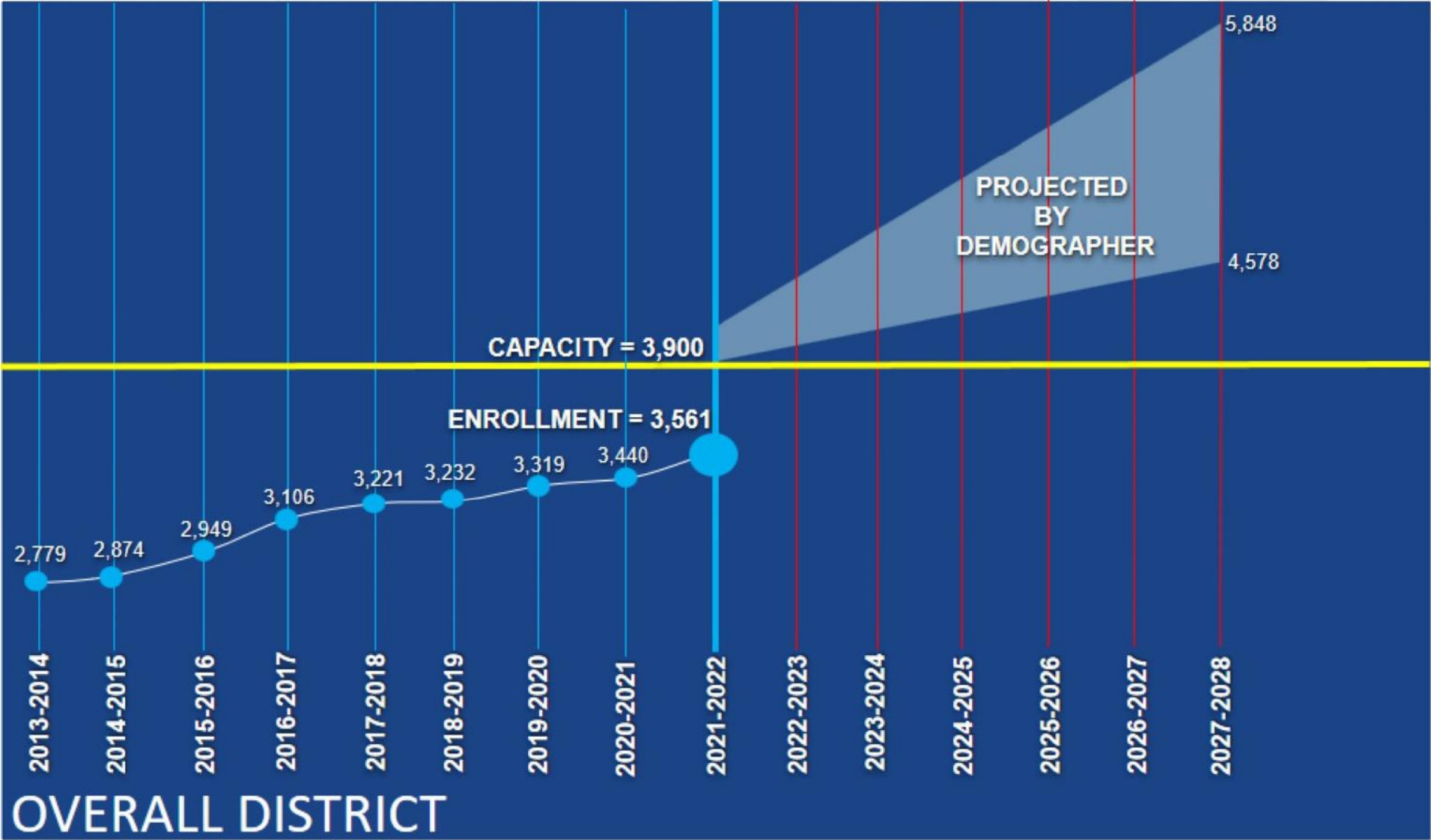
BOND ADVISORY COMMITTEE (BAC)

- 30+ members: parents, staff, community
- Heard information about:
 - Facility conditions & square footage limitations
 - Demographics
 - School finance
- Determined and prioritized district facility needs
- Feb. 17:
 - BAC presented recommendation to the Board of Trustees
 - Trustees accepted recommendation and voted unanimously to call a bond election for May 6, 2023



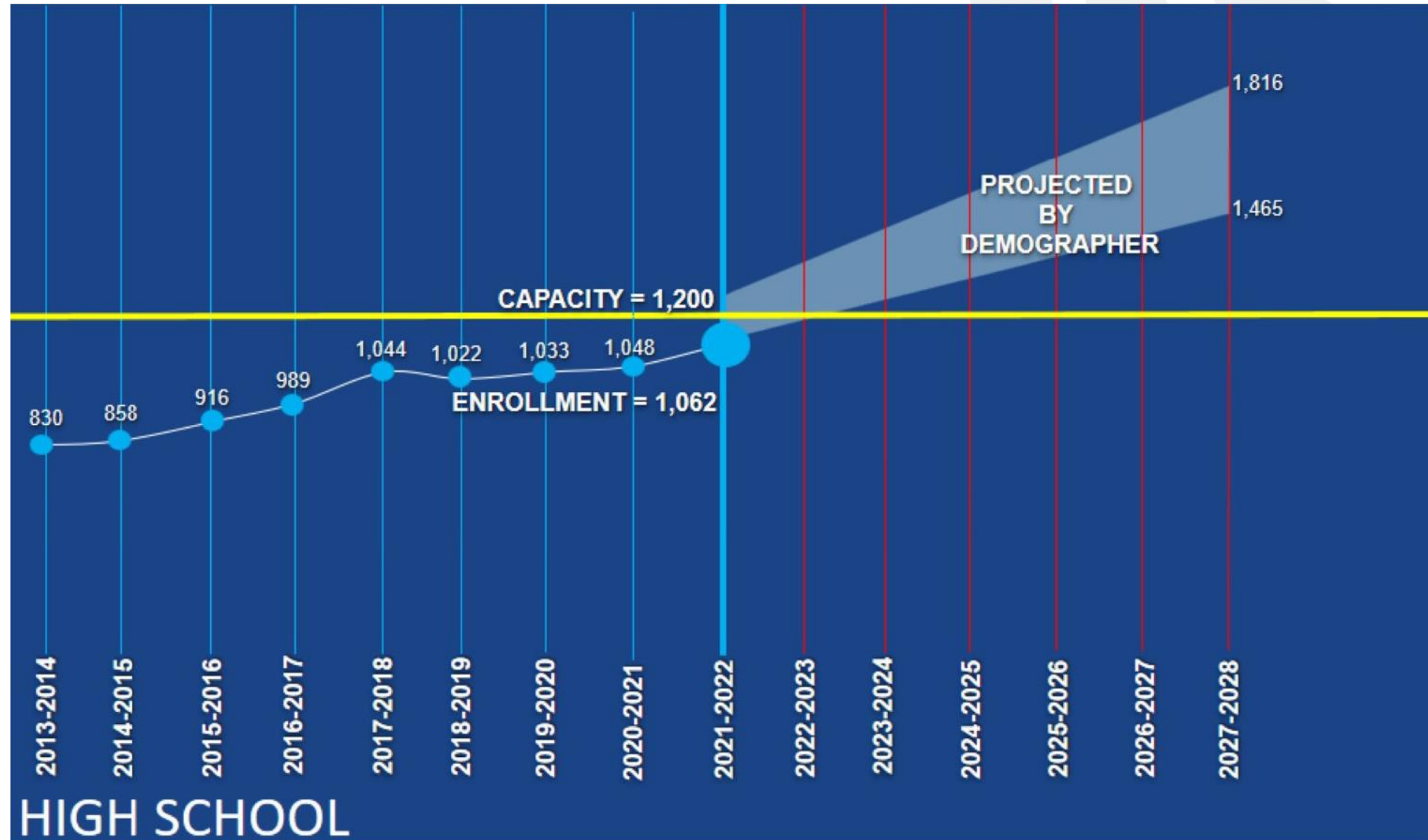
HOW WERE THE FACILITY NEEDS IDENTIFIED?

DISTRICT ENROLLMENT/CAPACITY



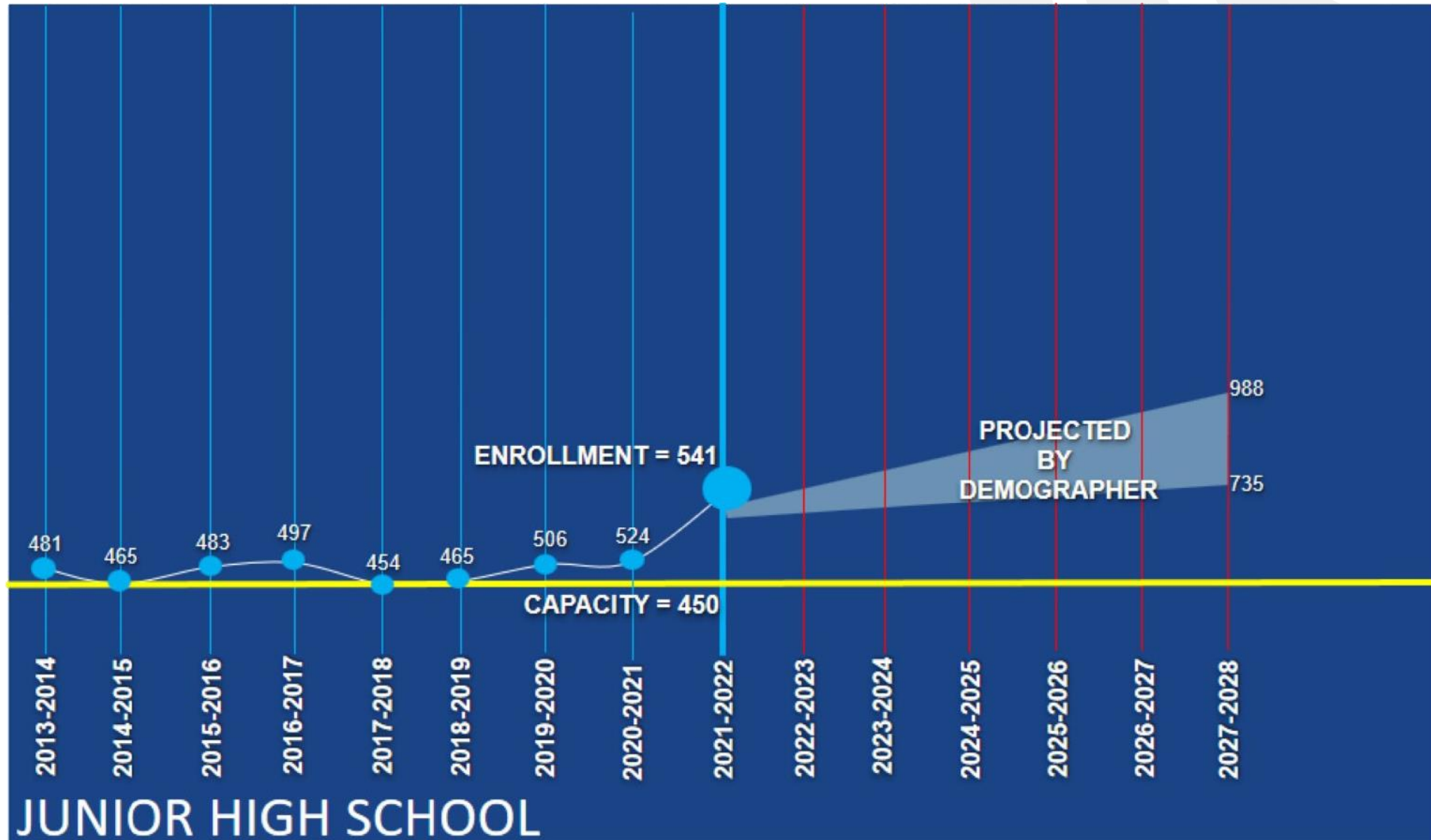

HIGH SCHOOL ENROLLMENT/CAPACITY



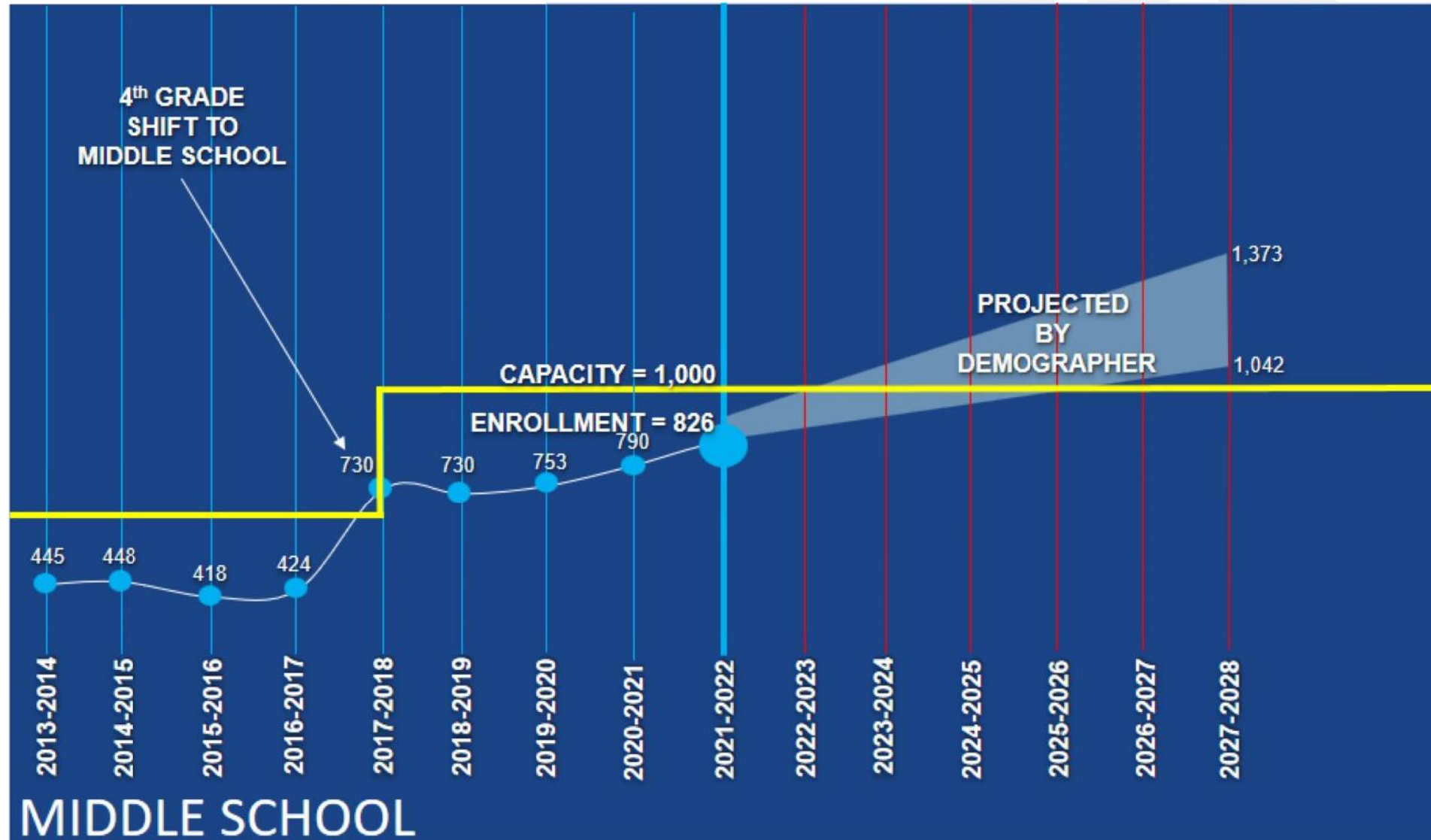

JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL ENROLLMENT/CAPACITY



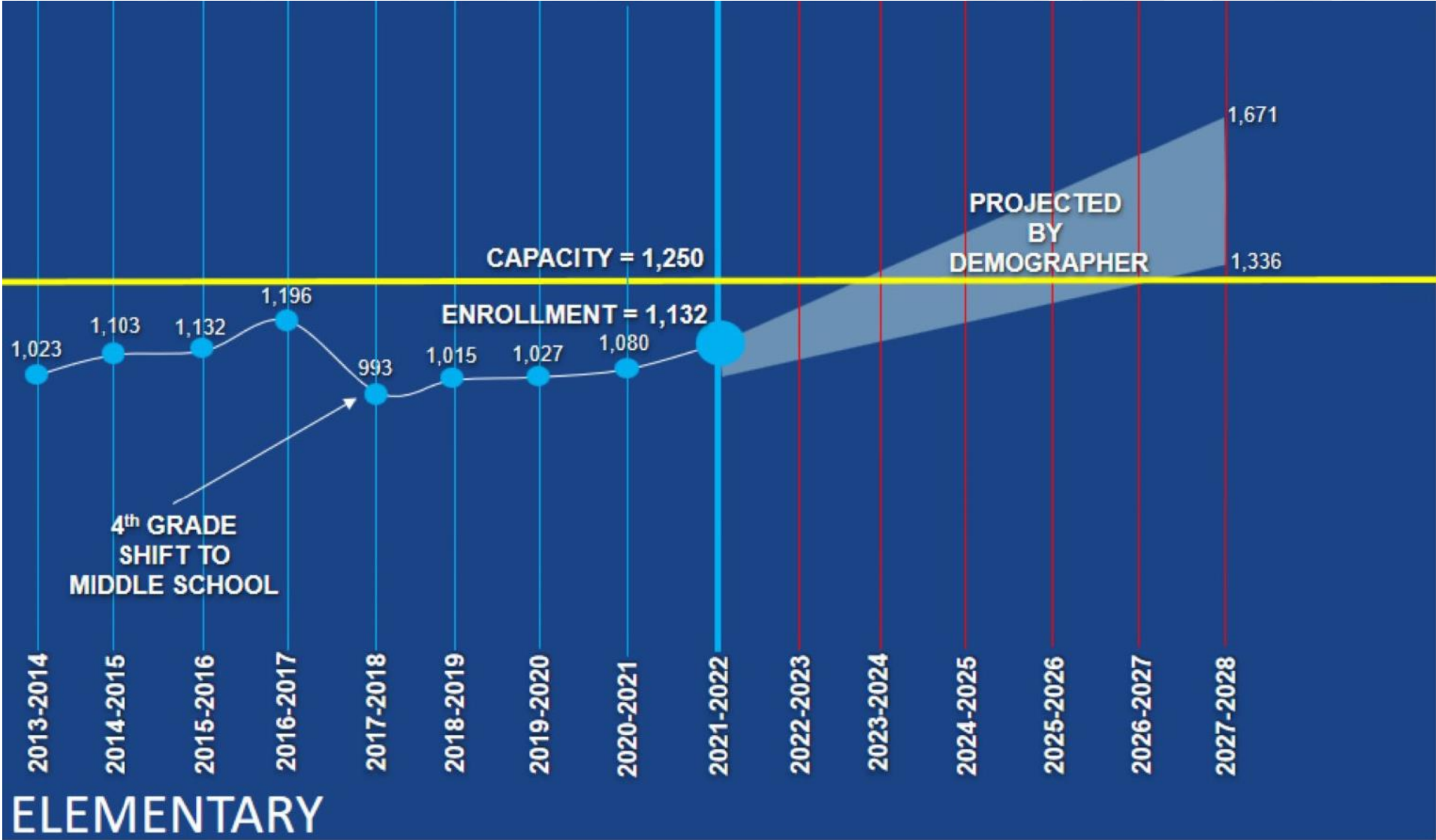

WHAT NEEDS DOES THIS BOND PROPOSAL ADDRESS?

- Focuses on current facility needs and a masterplan for the future
- Prepares for district enrollment growth
- Addresses overcrowding at junior high school and eliminates the need for portable classrooms
- Addresses overcrowding at the elementary
- Creates the ability to convert the current junior high to a 6th Grade Center
- Increases academic and athletic opportunities for students
- Improves campus safety and security
- Provides campus technology upgrades
- Updates current elementary and middle school campuses



WHAT ARE THE PROPOSED PROJECTS?



Proposition A

Proposition B

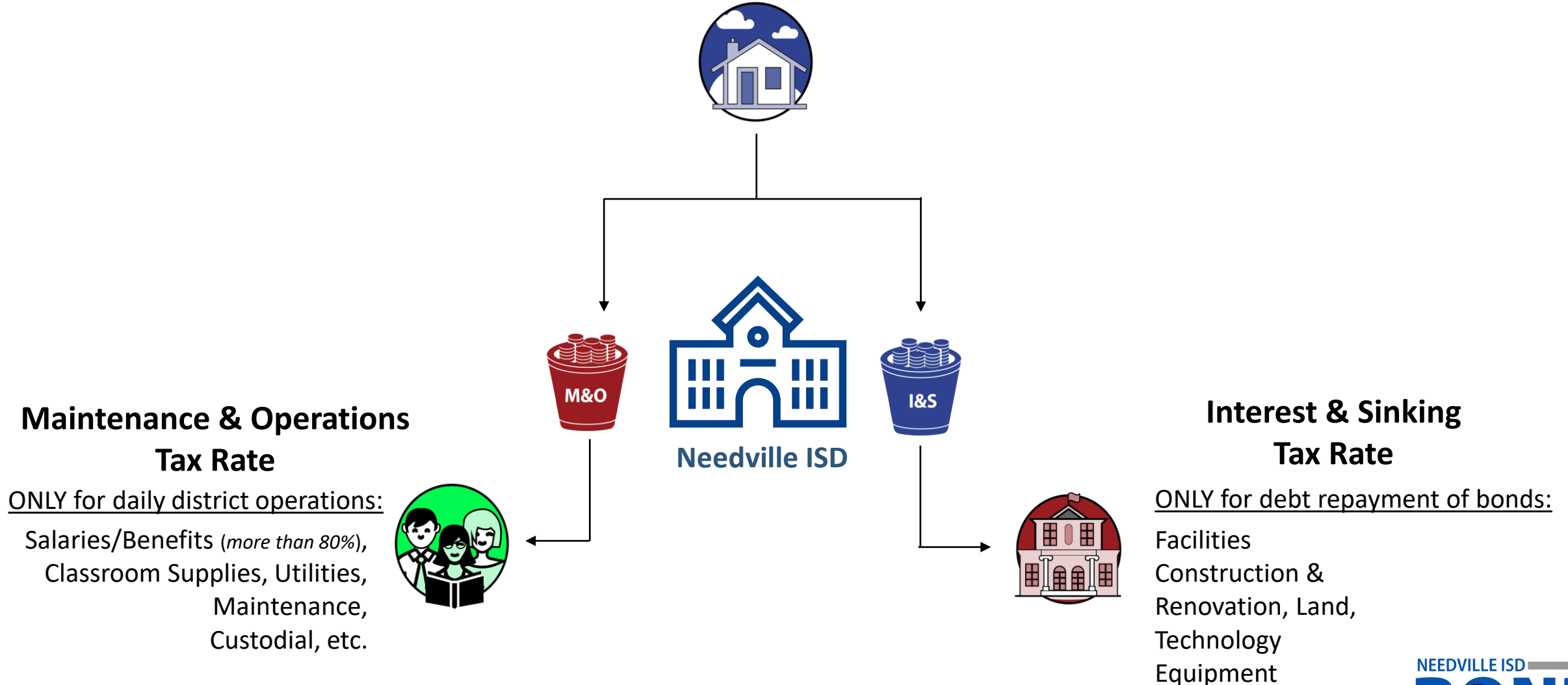
\$25M

HOW WOULD WE PAY FOR THE SCHOOL BOND PACKAGE?

Appraised Home Value	Taxable Value with Exemption*	Maximum Monthly Increase	Maximum Annual Increase
\$100,000	\$60,000	\$9.09	\$109.03
\$150,000	\$110,000	\$16.66	\$199.88
\$200,000	\$160,000	\$24.23	\$290.74
\$250,000	\$210,000	\$31.80	\$381.59

**Taxable values are based on the \$40,000 homestead exemption.*
